

**MINUTES OF MEETING OF PETTAUGH PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON  
13 May 2020 AT 6.30 p.m. BY VIDEO CONFERENCE**

Those present: Councillor Malcolm Owers (Chair), Councillor Belinda Bulsing, Councillor Stephen Rowe and Councillor Esther Thornton.

1. Apologies and note of Absences. None.
2. To receive any Declarations of Interest, Pecuniary and Non-Pecuniary. None.
3. To consider and agree the Minutes of Parish Council Meeting - 17th March 2020. Councillors voted to accept the resolution to approve the Minutes. The Minutes were approved as a true and correct record.
4. Public participation session - There were no issues raised by members of the public.
5. Consideration of Planning Application MSDC DC/20/01375 - Section 73 Application for planning permission without compliance of condition 18 attached to planning permission DC/19/05249, Stonham Barns, Pettaugh Road, Stonham Aspal. Following a detailed discussion, the Councillors agreed to submit a strong objection to this planning application. In addition, the Councillors requested that this application is to be considered by MSCD's planning committee and not dealt with under delegated powers by an officer.
6. Consideration of Planning Application MSDC DC/20/01438 - Application for planning permission for change of use of land for the stationing of five holiday lodges at Stonham Barns, Pettaugh Road, Stonham Aspal. The Councillors considered this further application at the Stonham Barns site. The Councillors agreed to object in the strongest possible terms to this application which, if granted, would exacerbate the problems at the site and would erode what little remains of the approved master planning approach.
7. Casual Vacancy. The Councillors noted the position.
8. To discuss arrangements for the Annual Meeting of the Council - The Councillors agreed to keep the date under review in light of the COVID 19 restrictions. The Clerks were instructed to contact SALC to seek further guidance.
9. Date and time of next meeting. 10 June 2020 at 6.30 p.m. in the Church (if the social distancing requirements are relaxed in time) or by video conference.
